

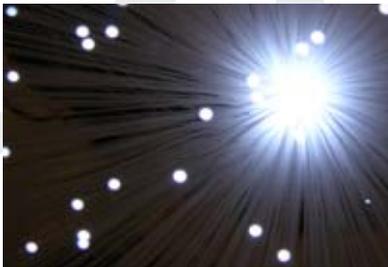


Sponsorship Opportunities for the 8th WRNP

Promoted by Rede Nacional de Ensino e Pesquisa (RNP – National Education and Research Network) since 1999, Workshop RNP (WRNP) is an annual event directed to advanced applications and high performance academic networks. WRNP integrates the programming of the Brazilian Symposium of Computer Networks and Distributed Systems (SBRC), one of the most traditional and highly regarded events of the kind.

The 8th WRNP is going to be held on May 28th and May 29th, 2007, in Belém, Pará state, during the 25th SBRC. In 2005, Ipê network started a nationwide operation. This year most of the 27 metropolitan high-speed networks created by Redecomep will start operating. The first one will be MetroBel, Belém's network, exactly where the event will take place. In the 8th WRNP, the intra-institutional optical networks will become a reality in the country.

and cyber infrastructure, which proposes the formation of powerful processing and information virtual infrastructures, commonly named grids, from the aggregation of resources such as computers, discs, data bank and large-scale instruments that give support to network services like data storage, management and mining.

Like the previous meetings, the 8th WRNP will gather the top-notch community of research and technology of networks and advanced applications: researchers, professionals and networks students, as well as representatives from governmental institutions and companies. Three hundred participants are expected to attend the 8th WRNP. SBRC will gather around 1,200 people.

In addition, the workshop attendance will offer great chances for private, academic and governmental partnerships, aiming at the development of high-speed networks in Brazil.
